### **Coastal Carolina Breast Center Represented at National Conference**

*Myrtle Beach, SC*--N. Craig Brackett, III, MD, FACS, President and Founder of Coastal Carolina Breast Center, along with Angela M. Mislowsky, M.D., were among the 1,300 physicians and surgeons attending the 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the American Society of Breast Surgeons.

In addition to the general sessions, Drs. Brackett and Mislowsky attended pre-conference educational sessions that included:

- Multimodality Detection and Diagnosis of Breast Diseases, and
- Intensive Breast Ultrasound; a Histopathologic-Based Approach to Detection and Diagnosis

They also attended a satellite symposium, sponsored by Genomic Health, entitled The Contemporary Management of Node-Positive Breast Cancer—Anatomy vs. Biology. This symposium focused on emerging data regarding treatment decision-making and difficult clinical scenarios relevant to clinicians who provide care to patients with early-stage breast cancer.

This year's conference was keynoted by Professor Ian O. Ellis, a 30-year veteran pathologist who has earned an international reputation in clinical and translational research in breast disease, particularly classification of breast cancer and evaluation of prognostic factors.

The American Society of Breast Surgeons is the primary leadership organization for general surgeons who treat patients with breast disease. Founded in 1995, the Society has grown to more than 3,000 members in the United States and 35 countries throughout the world. Its annual meeting provides a unique opportunity for breast health specialists to learn from, and interact with, leaders in the field of breast cancer in order to increase knowledge, apply new data to practice, and ultimately improve patient outcomes.

*Coastal Carolina Breast Center, one of only eight facilities in South Carolina accredited by the National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers (NAPBC), is the area's only practice dedicated solely to breast health. Breast specialist, N. Craig Brackett, III, MD, FACS, joined in practice by Angela M. Mislowsky, MD, has treated an estimated 25,000 patients during the last fifteen years.
