### **Dr. Angela M. Mislowsky Attends American Society of Breast Surgeons Meeting**

*Myrtle Beach, SC*—Angela M. Mislowsky, MD, of Coastal Carolina Breast Center, recently attended the American Society of Breast Surgeons (ASBS) 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting in Washington, DC, and was among those who participated in a full-day course on breast ultrasound and stereotactic certification.

This year's meeting which attracted over 1,200 attendees featured both research and scientific sessions focusing on both practice-changing surgical developments and what lies ahead for breast surgery over the next 5-10 years.

Topics included sentinel lymph node biopsy, developments in HER2/neu positive breast cancer treatments, a community tumor board, use of molecular genetic tests to stratify breast cancer risk, and recent developments on the treatment of benign breast diseases. In addition, the conference highlighted several newly available clinical trials.
