## Mislowsky Joins Coastal Carolina Breast Center

*Myrtle Beach, SC*--Angela M. Mislowsky, M.D. has joined Coastal Carolina Breast Center as a breast surgeon.

A Baltimore native, she earned her Doctor of Medicine at New York Medical College in Valhalla, New York. She obtained her undergraduate degrees in chemical and biomedical engineering at MIT in Cambridge, Massachusetts. As an undergraduate, she served as a Research Assistant at Johns Hopkins University and Medical Institute as well as Brigham and Women's Hospital, the renowned teaching affiliate of Harvard Medical School.

Dr. Mislowsky completed her residency in General Surgery at Union Memorial Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland, where during 2008-2009, she served as Chief Resident. She was a member of Union Memorial's Patient Care Advisory Committee and the recipient of both the Viresh Patel Award for outstanding work at the intern level and Union Memorial's Best Research Award.

Prior to joining Dr. N. Craig Brackett in practice earlier this fall, she completed her breast surgery and breast cancer fellowship training at the nationally recognized University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia where she also conducted research in the field of breast cancer.

Dr. Mislowsky has been published in several medical journals; most recently The Annals of Surgical Oncology, where she co-authored an article entitled "*Breast Cancer Surgery Trend Changes Since the Introduction of BRCA 1/2 Mutation Screening*". The published article falls on the heels of its presentation at the 2010 Annual Meeting of the American Society of Breast Surgeons in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Licensed in South Carolina, Pennsylvania and Maryland, Dr. Mislowsky is a member of the American Society of Breast Surgeons, the American College of Surgeons, the Society of Surgical Oncology, the Association of Women Surgeons and the American Medical Association.
